CYCLING, HOW IT BEGAN: Franky played ice hockey in Canada and started cycling when he was 12 years old. Years later he moved to Spain and started competing in cycling, road and track.

- He occasionally competes in Ultradistance Mountain Bike races in Mallorca and has won over 50 local road and track races in different age categories.
- He is the only Spanish rider to have done in a row Liège-Bastogne-Liège, Milan San Remo, Amstel Gold Race, Paris Roubaix and Tour of Flanders in the Gran Fondo version.
- He has done the most important Gran Fondos in Europe and participated every year in the 312 Mallorca.
- He is currently National Champion Ultradistance Duo Team (overall classification) (Moto GP Circuit in Cheste) and has the Ultradistance record of completing the whole loop of the 4 Balearic Islands under 28 hours (+700km).
- 8th Masters Track Cycling World Championship in Points Race in Manchester, 2019. 9th in Scratch.
- 5th Masters Track Cycling World Championship in Los Angeles in 2022 in Points Race and 7th in Scratch being sponsored by PONENT MAR CYCLING.
- Commissioner of the Balearic Cycling Federation (track and masters).
- Organizer of the Track Race GRUPO FLEMING at the Illes Balears Velodrome.

FAVOURITE ROUTE: The beautiful narrow paths from Campanet to Pollença, the climb to Sant Salvador in Felanitx and of course, all the climbs of Serra de Tramuntana.
